Dear Chairperson Vazdarjanova and Augusta University Senate Dispute Resolution and Grievance Committee,

It has come to my attention that Dr. Keel has issued his decision regarding the above-referenced complaint. Because I have provided some support to the Grievance Committee, I wanted to send this reminder to please pay special attention to Section 4 of the Faculty Grievance Policy with the caption "Disposition of Materials Collected." Section 4 restricts public dissemination of information from the Faculty Grievance Hearing process unless all parties agree. Section 4 states in part, "The findings and recommendations of the Faculty Grievance Subcommittee, its subcommittees, and the Formal Grievance Hearing Subcommittee may be made public only by action of all necessary parties included in the grievance."
